# **Buprenorphine Prescribed**

I4C Indicator MED-OPI-005: Buprenorphine Prescribed v 2.0

Category: Medication Management/Opioids

#### **Purpose:**

This indicator is used to identify patients with a current buprenorphine prescription used to treat opioid addiction.

#### Source:

Based on recommendation from CAMH for adding Buprenorphine to list of opioid indicators within BC's Health Data Coalition set of clinical measures.

#### **Base Population:**

All patients with an Active demographic status recorded in the EMR who have one or more current or past buprenorphine prescriptions for treating opioid addiction recorded in the EMR.

## **Indicator Segments:**

<u>Patients with current buprenorphine prescription:</u> Count of patients WITH one or more current buprenorphine prescriptions documented.

<u>Patients with only past buprenorphine prescription:</u> Count of patients WITHOUT any current buprenorphine prescription documented AND WITH one or more past buprenorphine prescriptions documented.

Current buprenorphine prescription is a medication identified by the brand or generic name containing 'buprenorphine' that is a current (not discontinued) medication.

Past buprenorphine prescription is a medication identified by the brand or generic name containing 'buprenorphine' that is a past (discontinued) medication.

## **Suggested Indicator Use:**

Physician or Practice use of this indicator is to identify or recall patients who currently or have previously been prescribed buprenorphine for treating opioid addiction.
