Purpose:

This indicator is used to identify patients who aren't immunized for Human papillomavirus (HPV).

Source:

Based on the HQO indicator framework version published October 2015.

Base Population:

All patients age 11-13 years old with an Active demographic status recorded in the EMR.

Indicator Segments:

<u>Immunization Received:</u> Count of patients age 11 to 13 years WITH an HPV vaccine documented as 'administered'.

<u>Immunization Overdue:</u> Count of patients age 11 to 13 years WITHOUT an HPV vaccine documented as 'administered'.

Suggested Indicator Use:

Physician or practice use of this indicator is to identify or recall patients who have not received an HPV vaccine.
