Category: Preventive Health Care/Smoking

Purpose:

This indicator is used to identify patients without smoking status documented.

Source:

Based on the AFHTO indicator framework version D2D 5.0 v1 published June 2017.

Base Population:

All patients age 12 and older with an Active demographic status recorded in the EMR.

Indicator Segments:

Smokers: Count of patient age 12 and older who are documented as current smokers.

<u>Nonsmokers</u>: Count of patient age 12 and older who are documented as non-smokers, including former smokers or people who never smoked.

Not documented: Count of patients age 12 and older without smoking status documented.

Suggested Indicator Use:

Physician or practice use of this indicator is to identify patients who haven't had smoking status documented and initiate the collection of smoking status for these patients.
