Indicator Query Segment Notes	<p>ACTIVE PATIENTS are patients identified as 'Active' in the Patient Status data element (DE01.016) within Patient Demographics</p> <p>HOSPITAL DISCHARGE NOTIFICATION is documented as a Report Received (DE14) where Report Class (DE14.009) = "Medical Record Report" and Report Sub-Class (DE14.010) begins with "D" or "DIP" or contains "Discharge Summary", OR Report Content (DE14.006) contains "The following patient was discharged from an inpatient unit" OR "The following patient was discharged from the Emergency Department" OR "Discharge Summary".</p> <p>DATE OF DISCHARGE is the date/time captured within Creation Date (DE14.004) of Reports Received (DE14).</p> <p>DATE OF DISCHARGE NOTIFICATION RECEIVED is the date/time captured within Receive Date (DE14.005) of Reports Received (DE14).</p> <p>FOLLOW-UP VISIT can be represented as an appointment (DE15.001) with with a physician or another clinician within the clinic, where appointments with status of 'No Show', 'Cancelled', or 'Deleted' are excluded, or may be based on any additional documentation supported by the EMR to record a patient visit (e.g., encounter notes).</p> <p>DATE OF FOLLOW-UP VISIT can be represented by Appointment Date/Time (DE15.001) or the date/time associated with any other documentation method with an EMR to record a patient visit (e.g., encounter note).</p> <p>Number of days between Hospital Discharge and Follow-up Visit can be calculated as the difference between the Date Of Discharge and the Date Of Follow-Up Visit.</p>

<p>Patient List Notes</p>	<p>PATIENT NAME is a combination of First Name (DE01.003) and Last Name (DE01.002) data items from Patient Demographics. Names may be displayed either as separate columns or concatenated into one column.</p> <p>UNIQUE PATIENT IDENTIFIER is any data item from Patient Demographics that can be used by a physician or clinic to uniquely identify a patient when displayed. Examples include Health Card Number (DE01.008) or Chart Number (DE01.012)</p> <p>PATIENT DATE OF BIRTH is captured into Patient Demographics as Date of Birth (DE01.007)</p> <p>PATIENT AGE is a calculated data item representing the difference between the current date and Date of Birth (DE01.007) from Patient Demographics. Age should be displayed in years.</p> <p>PATIENT PHONE NUMBER is the preferred phone number for contacting a patient, and may include Residence Phone (DE02.007), Cell Phone (DE02.008) or Work Phone (DE02.009) from Patient Address.</p> <p>HOSPITAL DISCHARGES WITHIN PAST YEAR is the count of Hospital Discharge Notifications received for a patient within the past 12 months.</p> <p>COUNT OF 7-DAY FOLLOW-UPS is the count of hospital discharge notifications received for a patient with a follow-up visit documented within 7 days after discharge over the past 12 months.</p>
